Driving Directions

Directions to the USTA National Tennis Center

BY SUBWAY

Take the IRT #7 Flushing subway from either Times Square or Grand Central to the Shea Stadium / Willets Point Station. The USTA National Tennis Center is about a three-minute walk down the ramp from the station.

Or take the IND "E" or "F" trains to Roosevelt Avenue and transfer upstairs to the IRT #7 train (Flushing bound) subway to the Shea Stadium / Willets Point Station. The USTA National Tennis Center is about a three-minute walk down the ramp from the station.

BY RAILROAD

The Long Island Railroad Port Washington branch departs from Penn Station to the USTA National Tennis Center (Shea Stadium / Willets Point Station). Contact the railroad for schedule information at (718)217-5477.

BY CAR

FROM NEW YORK CITY: Take the Triborough Bridge to the Grand Central Parkway (East) and take the Northern Blvd. (East) / Shea Stadium exit (exit #9E). Then exit at the Shea Stadium exit. At the exit ramp, make a right onto Stadium Road. Take that road straight and make a left at the second stop sign. The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your right.

FROM CONNECTICUT: Take I-95 to the Whitestone Bridge to the Van Wyck Expressway and exit at College Point Blvd.. At first light make a left onto College Point Blvd.. Take College Point Blvd. to Avery Avenue, making a left onto Avery Avenue. Go to the corner stop sign and make a right. Follow that road until you get to a stop sign and make a right. Go straight and The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your left.

FROM NORTHERN NEW JERSEY: Take the George Washington Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway (South). Then take the Triborough Bridge to the Grand Central Parkway (East) and take the Northern Blvd. (East) / Shea Stadium exit (exit #9E). Then exit at the Shea Stadium exit. At the exit ramp, make a right onto Stadium Road. Take that road straight and make a left at the second stop sign. The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your right.

FROM SOUTHERN NEW JERSEY: Take the Verrazzano Bridge to the Brooklyn – Queens Expressway to the Grand Central Parkway (East) and take the Northern Blvd. (East) / Shea Stadium exit (exit # 9E). Then exit at the Shea Stadium exit. At the exit ramp, make a right onto Stadium Road. Take that road straight and make a left at the second stop sign. The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your right.

BY BUS:

Take Long Island Expressway (LIE) and exit at College Point Blvd.. Take College Point Blvd. to Avery Avenue, making a left onto Avery Avenue. Go to the corner stop sign and make a right. Follow that road until you get to a stop sign and make a right. Go straight and The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your left.

**Team parking (vans) and spectator parking is available near the main entrance in Parking Lot A.
Bus parking is available near main entrance in Parking Lot B.**

Directions to LaGuardia Marriott:

From Eastbound Grand Central Pkwy:

Take the 94th St. Exit. to Ditmars Blvd. Proceed through traffic light. After the traffic circle the hotel will be on the left

From Westbound Grand Central Parkway (from USTA NTC):

Take 94th St. Exit. Make a Left at the light off 94th St. Proceed onto overpass, at first light make a left onto Ditmars Blvd. Hotel will be on left after traffic circle.

Directions to Saint Peter's College:

CARS: From USTA NTC/LaGuardia Marriott:

Take the Grand Central Parkway (West) to the Triborough Bridge. On the bridge, follow signs to Manhattan, then take FDR Drive North to the George Washington Bridge. After crossing the George Washington Bridge, follow the New Jersey Turnpike (Interstate 95) South to Exit 15E. Turn right onto Route 1-9 (Communipaw Avenue), cross over two bridges and pass Route 440. Continue to West Side Avenue (gas station on left). Turn left on West Side Avenue, turn right at Montgomery Street (4th traffic light). Saint Peter's College/Yanitelli Center is on the left.

BUSES: From USTA NTC/LaGuardia Marriott:

Take the Grand Central Parkway (West) to the Triborough Bridge. Cross the bridge, continuing to the Major Deegan Expressway (North). Follow signs for Cross Bronx Expressway (West) to George Washington Bridge. After crossing the George Washington Bridge, follow the New Jersey Turnpike (Interstate 95) South to Exit 15E. Turn right onto Route 1-9 (Communipaw Avenue), cross over two bridges and pass Route 440. Continue to West Side Avenue (gas station on left). Turn left on West Side Avenue, turn right at Montgomery Street (4th traffic light). Saint Peter's College/Yanitelli Center is on the left.
